CITY COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY JUNE 14, 2022- 7:00 P.M.**

Mayor Brooks Valls opened the meeting thanking everyone for their hard work during Homecoming then with the pledge of allegiance. Councilmember Kendall Funderburk led with a prayer. A quorum was present with all members present. Proper posting of the meeting was confirmed.

Consent Items: Minutes from the last meeting, accounts payable, and current general ledgers were reviewed. A motion by Cullen Freeman was made to approve. Kendall Funderburk seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion and take action on Sign on City Office Building. Ronnie Funderburk made a motion to hire Rory Skagen from Blue Genie Art Industries for \$2,300 to paint the mural on the side of the City Office building. This will be paid out of the funds from the sell of the old City Office. Kendall Funderburk seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion and take action on Garbage Rate Increase. Frontier Waste rates are going up 10%. Ronnie made a motion to accept the rate increase. Kelli Eno seconded. Motion carried. City garbage rates will be looked at during budget time.

Discussion and take action on Limestone County Interlocal Agreement- American Rescue Plan Funds. Ronnie Funderburk made a motion to accept \$135,000 from Limestone County to be used for water projects. Cullen Freeman seconded. Motion carried.

Charles Dickerson gave the Water report. Produced 1.8 million gallons. No major leak. Hwy 14 and Monroe leak was repaired. Charles will be on vacation Sat June 18th to Sat 26th. Karen will run the water route every morning. The new employee has already quit and Jake Smith in two weeks.

City Secretary Christina Lockhart gave the City/Court Report Tomorrow there is a city-wide power outage 6am-1pm. The KCC will be open. Office will open when the power is back on. Both Grants are in environmental stages. 87 Citations were turned into the state. Court will resume in August.

PD Report. 103 tickets 2 arrests.

Karen Partin gave the EDC report. A new sign east of town is in the process. The EDC had dropped the grant for the ball park but have reopened and are going to get a splash pad at the City Park. The EDC had two incentive requests. The property sells and buying is not happening at this time. Debbie Suttle is donating Bobby Joe buggy that he had used in the parade in years past.
