KOSSE COMMUNITY HEALTH CLINIC

The City of Kosse has been awarded a \$2.3 million grant to expand the Kosse Community Health Clinic. The Clinic has been very successful. The expansion will add over 2,500 square feet that will provide space for another provider. Construction should start later this year.

PRESERVATION TEXAS WORKING ON OLD CITY HALL

The old City Hall building, built in 1915, at 103 N Narcissus was purchased by Preservation Texas as the site for their future Visitor Center for the Bassett Farm Conservancy. Work has begun to bring it back to its early 1900's look. Preservation Texas recently completed at \$900,000 restoration on the Bassett House and several historic structures on the 2,400 acre site just west of Kosse.
