CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Brooks Valls opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. Mayor Brooks Valls led with a prayer. A quorum was present with all members present. Proper posting of the meeting was confirmed.

Consent Items: Minutes from the last meeting, accounts payable, and current general ledgers were reviewed. A motion by Ronnie Funderburk was made to approve. Kendall Funderburk seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Update on Kosse Project 150. The floor has been completed next week the sheetrock will be installed. It may be open enough at Homecoming for people to tour the building. Christina and Karen have been working on getting the current city office cleaned out and ready to move.

Discussion and take action on Swear in Councilmembers. Mayor Brooks Valls swore in Kendall Funderburk and Cullen Freeman as they were unopposed in the May 1,2021 election. They will serve a two-year term.

Discussion and take action on Frontier Waste Solutions Rate Increase. Council had discussed this at the workshop in April. Since that meeting City Attorney Mike Dixon spoke to Frontier Waste and they have reduced the increase to 4%. Kendall Funderburk made a motion to accept the contract with Frontier Waste and to raise garbage rates by \$1.00 to cover the raise effective July 1, 2021. Kelli Eno seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion and take action on Adoption of Ordinance 05112021- Water and Sewer Rates. Mayor Brooks Valls stated in this new ordinance there is a \$6.00 reduction to all the water base rates. All ordinances for water/sewer have been combined into this one ordinance to make it easier going forward. We have had requests for water outside city limits and this ordinance explains how that process works. Cullen Freeman made a motion to adopt Ordinance 05112021 to go in effect July 1,2021. Harley seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the new ordinance is available at the City Office.

Discussion and take action on Establishing City Park Hours. Chief New has expressed interest in getting park hours established. Kendall Funderburk made a motion to set the park hours at 6 am to 11 pm. Kelli Eno seconded. Motion carried. Mayor Brooks Valls stated that an ordinance will be drawn up by City Secretary and brought to pass at the next City Council meeting.
