Harley Leazer seconded. Motion carried. A public hearing will be at the begin of the next council meeting on September 14th.

Charles Dickerson gave the Water report. Produced 1.5 million gallons. Small leaks due to heat increase. Hired a new employee, Bryan Correa.

Court Clerk Christina Lockhart gave the Municipal Court report. No report.

Chief New gave the police report. 136 citations. Robert Koch put in his resignation and his last day was July 31st. Looking for a new officer that will fit in here. The bullet proof inserts are good.

Brooks Valls gave the EDC report. TWDB update-Waiting on bid for pavilion. Stacy Lockhart and Brooks Valls were sworn in as new members on the EDC.
