CITY COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 15, 2019 - 7:00 P.M.**

Mayor Jarrod Eno opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. LB Perry led with the prayer. A quorum was present with all members present. Proper posting of the meeting was confirmed.

Consent Items: Minutes from the last meeting, accounts payable, and current general ledgers were reviewed. A motion by Harley Leazer was made to approve. Brooks Valls seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discuss and Take Action on Consider House Offer. An offer of \$38,000 was made, after they came and inspected the house they backed out of the deal. This house needs a lot of work. There is an offer of \$30,000. Brooks Valls made a motion to accept the offer of \$30,000. Ronnie Funderburk seconded. Motion carried.

Discuss and Take Action on Generator Repairs. Ronnie Funderburk knows someone that works on generators and said he would give the city a bid on fixing them. 1 runs but 2 needs a little work. Brooks made a motion to get a bid and repair the generators with a budget up to \$5,000 and purchase 4 batteries. Jimmy Pate seconded. Motion carried.

Discuss and Take Action on Propose Tax Rate for 2019-2020. Ronnie Funderburk proposed the effective tax rate of \$0.6136 2019-2020. Harley Leazer seconded. Motion carried. Mayor Eno explained that this is a tax rate decrease from last year because of the developments and growth of Kosse we have been able to lower the tax rate again as we have done the past years.

Charles Dickerson gave the water report. About 1.5 million gallons used. They will be boring under the Railroad soon. Looks like they are still on schedule to finish at the End of September.

Court Clerk Christina Lockhart in July there was no Court was held. 103 Convictions were turned into the state and 20 warrants were issued.

Police Chief Morris gave the police report. 174 Citations were written. 6 Arrests. 8th month with no crime.
