ORDINANCE NO. 11082022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KOSSE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 04122022 BURN BAN IN THE CITY LIMITS OF KOSSE AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KOSSE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1 will include

In addition to the Limestone County Burn Ban Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning the following is prohibited in the City of Kosse:

All outdoor fires, including fires contained in a container or semi-enclosure, such as a barrel or fire pit. (It does not include grills, barbeques, or smokers which are used to cook food and are fully covered and attended). Open grills, barbeques or smokers are prohibited.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication of its caption as required by law.

Discussion and take action on Amendment to The City of Kosse Policy & Procedure Employee Manual. Charles Dickerson gave the Water report. Produced 1.7 million gallons. Major Leak a couple weeks ago. Councilman Cullen Freeman asked about the sewer issue that was reported last month. Charles stated it cleared up in about 4 days. Could not find the cause.

City Secretary Christina Lockhart gave the City/Court Report

62 Citations turned into the state. 16 warrants issued. Will resume court in January. Closed this Friday for Veterans Day. Still working on the Water Tower Project. Met with USDA last week. USDA does not have grant writers and it is all up to the engineer and I to get everything submitted, only possible to get up to a 45% precent grant, rest would be loan. I going to reach out to Texas Water Development board and see what funding they have available. Letters were sent out today to the vacant dilapidated homeowners. There are 8 homes we will focus on. If hearings are needed, they will be brought in front of council in February.

Police Chief Brett New gave the PD Report. 162 citations. 1 arrest. Officer Lewis stopped his first passing of the school bus. Light bar is fixed and the ballistic windshield was installed.

Karen gave the EDC Report. Splash pad is in the works. Engineer is working on the paperwork. Food Truck Park is in the works, we build it hopefully they will come. Kosse T building will be moving to the property the Food Truck Park is at.

Brooks Valls gave the KCC report. Thursday is the community dinner. Ricky Waller will be there to pray. The stage is almost completed. Bingo on Friday for the KHS.

Chief Kendall Funderburk gave the report. No update on the life pack. The county is waiting on the funds to complete the radio switch over. The Fire Department has purchased the radios so they are ready.
