CITY COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY JULY 9,2024- 7:00 P.M.**

Mayor Brooks Valls opened the with the pledge of allegiance and Kendall Funderburk led with a prayer. A quorum was present with all members present. Proper posting of the meeting was confirmed.

Consent Items: Minutes from the last meeting, accounts payable, and current general ledgers were reviewed. A motion by Ronnie Funderburk was made to approve. Cullen Freeman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Visitors- Trish Roy was present and spoke about fireworks on her end of town. They are so loud and shake her home. She also had other neighbors present and said they express the same concerns she does. She does not have an issue with fireworks but the ones that have been used are some she has never experienced and they are so loud. She asked for the firework ordinance be revisited. Christina explained that since this was not on the agenda a councilmember will need to make a motion to place this issue on the next agenda.

Discussion and take action on Road Closure Request. Todd Freeman made a motion to close the portion of Harrison, Rose and Jackson Street in Ronnie Funderburk's plot of land. Kelli Eno seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion and take action on City Tractor Purchase. There were 7 quotes provided to replace the 2007 Tractor that has broken down. The repair for the 2007 could be upwards to \$4,000. After discussion on all the quotes, Kendall Funderburk made a motion to purchase the Kubota Tractor from Normangee Tractor for \$35,900 with funds from the Water/Sewer Reserve funds. Todd seconded. Motion carried.

Kendall made a motion to place the Firework Ordinance on the August agenda. Kelli Eno seconded. Motion carried.

Charles Dickerson gave the Water report. Produced 1.6 million gallons. No leaks last month. One at the clinic now. Went out of compliance at the wastewater treatment plant 2 or 3 times due to the 22 inches of rain. But should not get any violations. Due to the storms, homecoming the water department is behind schedule. He has a sewer line and waterline that needs to be put in. June 18 there was a TCEQ investigation. Only had 2 minor violations. Passed and will be good until 2027. He had to obtain a Designated Representative license. Also in the process of obtaining a CSI license.
