Water Well Project

The Water Well Project is now in full swing again now that the issue with the Houston Toad has been solved. The City will no longer be constructing a water tower but will instead install pressurized tanks and ground storage tanks with large pumps. This will function the same as a water tower. The project was re-engineered using pressure tanks as a way around postponing construction for three years while environmental experts study the proposed tower site to determine the toad is not there. The pressure tanks will provide the pressure and water supply to town in place of a water tower, with no change or limitation in water service to our community.

Kosse Medical Clinic

The original bids for the construction for the Medical Clinic came in very over budget. Since then, the Mayor and Engineer has explored all options on getting the project in budget. The project will be set for Re-Bidding in the next couple weeks. Hopefully the bids will come in budget and we can get started on the construction. If everything goes well, it looks like Limestone Medical Center will be able to be in the Medical Clinic by the end of this year.

Easter Egg Hunt

Sales Tax

The Kosse Sales Tax allocations have continued to increase in the past months compared to this time last year. The City received \$7408 in March, up 16.42 percent from March 2017, where the City received \$6192. This is great for the news for the future and sustainability of our town.

Update Phone Numbers

This will help the City get in contact with you if there is a leak at your residence or an outage that is going to occur. You will still receive a copy of your water bill but you will not have to deal with the hassle of getting out and paying your bill. Auto-Draft is drafted just like a check on the $10^{\rm th}$ of every month. If you are interested in this service, call or swing by the office and get set up.
