Sewer Issues

A sewer Audit was just performed by TCEQ, and they have cited the city too much rain water getting into the sewer, causing overflow problems. The biggest contributor to this problem is open or broken clean outs. The city is responsible for ensuring the sewer system operates normally and public works personnel will be repairing any broken or missing clean out covers. The expense of the new cap will be added to the water bills of any clean outs repaired on private property.

City Wide Clean-Up

The City is working hard to clean up around town and abandoned properties in town. Please join in our efforts and get Kosse cleaned up for Homecoming. The dumpster for City Wide Clean-Up will be available from May 16th until May 30th. The city will be sprayed for mosquitoes the week of homecoming. The spraying will occur late at night, and for three nights in a row. It is recommended that you do not go outside and play in the vapor cloud as the truck passes by your home. The mosquitoes are very bad this year. Please check your property and make sure there are no containers or tubs holding water that mosquitoes can use as a breeding ground. We understand that drainage of the ditches is an issue in some places and plans are being made to work on the trouble areas to enable better drainage.
